It can be used for cleaning and degreasing before priming and painting, for cleaning machine parts, or before other WEICON products are applied to surfaces where a greasy underground would impair their effect.

Processing

Spray in sufficient quantity onto the part to be treated and allow to react. If necessary, wipe off with a clean cloth. Repeat process as required. Avoid contact with plastic and varnished surfaces.

Pressurized container. Protect from direct sunlight and temperatures above +50°C.
